Meeting with the Trade Commissioner (Education) of the Consulate General of Canada

On January 24th, 2019, at UFABC, we welcomed Fernanda Albano, Trade Commissioner (Education) of the Consulate General of Canada. Professors Wagner Carvalho (Vice-President of UFABC), João Paulo Gois (Vice-Provost of Graduate Studies), and Dalmo Mandelli (International Relations Advisor) attended this meeting.

During the meeting, we detailed the pedagogical plan of UFABC, and how it was used as the basis for the construction of our Internationalization Project (Capes-PrInt). We presented the four priority research themes within PrInt, as well as the projects and the Graduate Programs that are enrolled with the Capes-PrInt.

According to Fernanda, Canadian universities have shown a great interest in contributing to our Internationalization Project. We could identify some lines of research that share the same goals of Canadian research collaborators, allowing us to establish new partnerships with Canada, which is already one of the main partners of UFABC.

Based on the objectives of the Capes-PrInt project of UFABC, Fernanda will mediate the search for Canadian institutions that have affinities with our Internationalization Project.
